The dedication of the Lateran Basilica

Sunday November 9th - In the words of Pope Benedict XVI (9 November 2008): 'Today's feast celebrates a mystery that is always relevant: God's desire to build a spiritual temple in the world, a community that worships him in spirit and truth' (cf. John 4: 23–24). The Basilica of St. John Lateran was the first to be built after the edict (313) of Emperor Constantine, and is the ecclesiastical seat of the Bishop of Rome. As a result, it is called 'the mother and head of all the churches of the city and the world'.
